

Acme Steel Will Increase Prices Of Hot Rolled Carbon and Alloy Steel Products Sept. 30, 1996

RIVERDALE, Ill., Aug. 21 /PRNewswire/ -- Acme Steel Company (NYSE: AMI) will increase published base prices approximately 4.0 percent dependent on product, effective with shipments Sept. 30, 1996, or later, for hot rolled carbon and alloy sheet and strip steel products.

"Published prices of these products will increase \$15 per net ton," announced Jerry D. Kendall, senior vice president commercial.

Acme Steel Company is a fully integrated producer of flat rolled sheet and strip steel products, specializing in the low-, mid-, and high-carbon; alloy; and special grades.
