## ACME STEEL COMPANY

TO INSURANCE AGENTS AND BROKERS:

Re: Certificate of Insurance

Acme Steel Company proposes to enter into a work agreement on its Form CO-59 with

Under the terms of the agreement the Contractor is required to provide Comprehensive Liability Insurance, including Contractual Liability Coverage covering such agreement, insuring the Contractor in the following amounts:

- A. Bodily Injury Liability: Not less than \$1,000,000 for liabilities arising out of bodily injury to or death of one person and a total of not less than \$1,000,000 for all liabilities arising out of bodily injuries to or death of two or more persons in any one occurrence;
- B. Property Damage: Not less than \$500,000 for liabilities arising out of injuries to or destruction of property in any one occurrence; and
- C. Wherever applicable to this agreement, Automobile Liability: Not less than \$500,000 for liabilities arising out of bodily injury to or death of one person and a total of not less than \$1,000,000 for all liabilities arising out of bodily injuries to or death of two or more persons in any one occurrence; and Property Damage Liability in the amount of not less than \$500,000 for liabilities arising out of injuries to or destruction of property in any one occurrence.

In order to provide evidence of insurance satisfactory to Acme you should furnish Acme with Certificate(s) of Insurance certifying that coverages and limits have been provided as indicated above. Such Certificate(s) shall name Acme Steel Company as an **additional named insured** under the policies evidenced thereby. To facilitate the entering into of subsequent contracts with said Contractor on Acme Form No. CO-59 without the necessity of repetitious issuance of certificates of insurance, such Certificate(s) should also contain a statement worded as follows:

"The insurance herein described is extended to include liability assumed by the Insured in all agreements entered into by the Insured and Acme Steel Company upon Acme Form CO-59, during the terms of such policies. Notice of any change in or cancellation of any of such insurance will be furnished Acme Steel Company not less than ten days prior to the effective date of such change or cancellation."

We would appreciate your expediting the furnishing of such Certificate(s), in duplicate, as the Contractor will not be permitted to enter upon our property until such evidence of insurance is in our hands.

CONTRACTOR'S AGREEMENT

The undersigned contractor (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), in consideration of the issuance to Contractor by ACME STEEL COMPANY (hereinafter referred to as "Acme") of a purchase order hereinafter identified, covenants and agrees, effective as of the date of such purchase order, as follows:

1. Contractor shall, and shall require each Subcontractor to, use and provide all proper, necessary and sufficient precautions, safeguards and protections against the happening of any damages to property or injuries to any person or persons during or resulting from the work covered by such purchase order. Contractor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Acme against and from all losses, damages, injuries and deaths (including losses or damages to property of Acme occupied, used by or in the care, custody or control of Contractor or in proximity to the site of said work, and including injuries or deaths sustained by any employee, workman, servant or agent of Contractor or any Subcontractor), and all claims and liabilities therefor, arising out of said work to the extent caused, whether in whole or in part, by any act or omission, negligent or otherwise, of Contractor or any Subcontractor or of any employee, workman, servant or agent of Contractor or any Subcontractor. Contractor shall not be obligated to indemnify or hold Acme harmless from Acme's negligence.

2. Contractor shall, and shall require each Subcontractor to, comply with the provisions of all local, State and Federal laws and Statutes, including the Federal Social Security Act, Federal Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 as amended, including Sec. 12(a), and the Unemployment Compensation and Workmen's Compensation Laws (including Occupational Disease Laws) of the State of \_\_\_\_\_ in effect during the period of time required for the work covered by said purchase order, and Contractor shall furnish to Acme certificates evidencing such compliance.

3. Prior to commencement of such work, and until completion thereof and final payment therefor, Contractor shall at his or its own cost procure and keep in effect Comprehensive Liability Insurance (including Contractual Liability) covering this agreement and insuring Contractor in the following amounts:

- A. Bodily Injury Liability: Not less than \$1,000,000 for liabilities arising out of bodily injury to or death of one person and a total of not less than \$1,000,000 for all liabilities arising out of bodily injuries to or death of two or more persons in any one occurrence;
B. Property Damage: Not less than \$500,000 for liabilities arising out of injuries to or destruction of property in any one occurrence; and
C. Automobile Liability: Not less than \$500,000 for liabilities arising out of bodily injury to or death of one person and a total of not less than \$1,000,000 for all liabilities arising out of bodily injuries to or death of two or more persons in any one occurrence; and Property Damage Liability in the amount of not less than \$500,000 for liabilities arising out of injuries to or destruction of property in any one occurrence.

The Insurance to be provided by the Contractor pursuant to this paragraph 3 shall name Acme as an additional named insured.

4. If the referenced purchase order provides for the construction, erection or installation of property before title is acquired by Acme, prior to furnishing materials and until transfer of title, Contractor shall at his or its own cost procure and maintain Fire and Extended Coverage Insurance insuring Contractor and protecting such materials and property in amounts and by policies with insurance companies approved by Acme.

5. Contractor shall furnish to Acme a certificate of insurance certifying that Contractor has in effect the insurance required by Paragraphs 3 and 4 hereof. Such certificate of insurance shall state that the insurance company will notify Acme in writing by registered mail at least ten (10) days prior to any change in or cancellation of any of the insurance in effect as certified by such certificate.

6. Contractor shall schedule the hours of work necessary to complete the work covered by said purchase order so that the same will not interfere with the operations of Acme's plant.

Contractor further agrees to conform to and abide by the safety rules and regulations of Acme while doing any work in or on the premises of Acme.

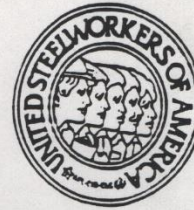
