Dear Mr. O'Hearn:

We are pleased to quote you the sum of \$54,945.00 to repair the propane standby system at Acme Steel as follows:

1. Replace the expansion joint material between the concrete foundations and the tanks on the two existing 30,000 gallon LP tanks.
2. Rebuild the existing primary shut-off valves in the bottom of the two 30,000 gallon tanks.
3. Visually inspect the existing primary excess flow valves and float gauges in the two storage tanks.
4. Replace the tank vapor relief valves, breakaway adapters and relief valve stack on the two storage tanks.
5. Manifold the two 30,000 gallon tanks together with two 2" liquid line and one 1½" vapor line. We will be reusing most of the existing pipe fittings.
6. Install two new Corken 521EF-103 feed pumps with 5 h.p. 3 p.h. 1800 r.p.m. explosion proof motors.

These pumps will be piped so they can be two staged during severely cold weather pumping.

7. Install one rebuilt Algas 50,000 h. vaporizer-mixer capable of supplying 72,000,000 B.T.U.H. of 1450 B.T.U. per cubic foot propane-air mix at 5 P.S.I.G.

We will tie the mixer into the existing mixed gas receiver.

We will also run a new 2" liquid line above ground from the vaporizer mixer to the two 2" Corken pumps.

8. Install a new transport unloading riser in place of the existing riser that will meet present N.F.P.A. Pamphlet #58 Code.

We will run a new 2" liquid line and 1½" vapor line above ground from the riser to the two 30,000 gallon storage tanks.

9. Install two new combination starters and start-stop switches to supply electrical service to the two Corken pumps.

Your company will be responsible for supplying the electrical service to the starters.

This quotation does not include:

1. Any repairs to the existing 30,000 gallon storage tanks or to the mixed gas receiver and mixed gas piping.
2. Any repairs to the existing concrete tank foundations or to the vaporizer-mixer pad.
3. Any painting.
4. Cost incurred if we are required to hire labor not normally employed by Petrolane Gas Service.
5. Disposing of the existing vaporizer-mixer.
6. State and local permits or taxes.

The rebuilt vaporizer-mixer carries a nine month warranty and is subject to prior sale.


